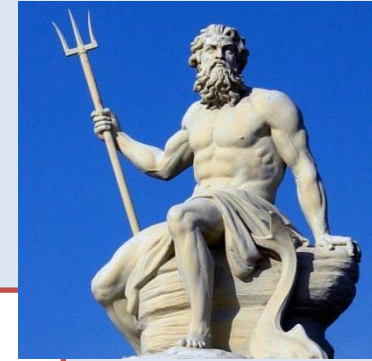

Maths

- Place value-
 - beyond 1000
 - rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
 - Comparing and ordering numbers

 - Mental maths
 - Times tables- recalling facts up to 12×12



Multiplication tables check

- Department for Education – 2019/20
- Online.
- The national curriculum specifies that pupils should be taught to recall the multiplication tables up to and including 12×12 by the end of year 4.
- It is used to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.
