

Antelope Class Easter activities

Happy Easter Antelopes! Next term we are going to be learning about the Rainforest. Here are a few activities, based on this, which you could have a go at over the Easter holidays.

Leaf-printing - take a leaf and use paint to carefully cover the top. Press the painted side onto a piece of paper and slowly reveal the pattern.



Create 'animal tracks' by drawing, printing or making imprints in the mud. Take pictures for evidence.

Design a new rainforest animal.

The Rainforest

Whilst outside, close your eyes and imagine you are standing in the middle of a rainforest. Write or draw to show what you imagine that you will hear, see, smell and feel.

Make a Rain stick
Use the cardboard from a toilet roll, paper, elastic band or a hair-tie, tin foil and rice to create a rain stick.
