Move

See if you can find a local map with all the waterways. What do you notice about where towns and villages are and the water courses?

Present your findings in an interesting way.

Practise

We have been revisiting negative numbers. Look at all the things around the house and talk to adults, to find out as many ideas as you can of where we use negative numbers.

Make a booklet about negative numbers.

Observe and explore

Go to a local river or canal and see if you can find and signs about the water level (near a bridge).

What else do you notice? Can you make a presentation about the things you have found?

Talk

Talk to an adult and make a list of all the ways rivers are used for leisure time.

Collect some pictures and make a scrap book or poster ready to share your ideas in class.

Can you make an investigation to measure rainfall over the next few weeks?

Find ways to present your findings that will be exciting for the class to see.

Question

Can you write a list of questions that you would like to ask about what water companies do.
