This term in art, the children will be learning about printing. They will learn how to make printing blocks and will then use this to recreate their own version of 'The Moon' by

PE

Maths

We will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction. Some of the skills that are covered include:

1. Ordering and comparing numbers
2. Adding and subtracting 10 and 100
3. Number bonds to 100
4. Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s
5. Add and subtract three 1-digit numbers
6. Add and subtract 2-digit numbers from a 3-digit number

History

This term we will be learning about the chronology of space travel, finding out about Neil Armstrong and Mae Jemison, using sources to find out about the first trip to the moon and comparing technology from the first space flights to today. We will also look at the impact that early space travel has had on today.

English

English this term consists of Read, Write, Inc and creative writing lessons. In our writing lessons, we are using the book, 'Field Trip to the Moon', to inspire us.
