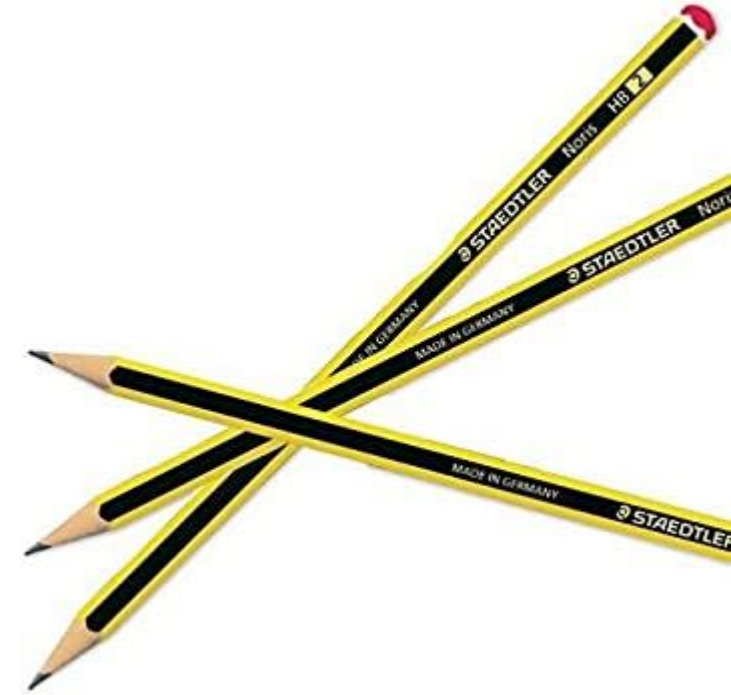

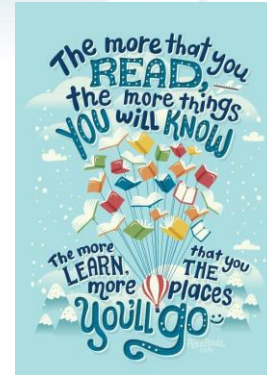

 <b>Move</b> Can you hold 2 standing balances and 2 floor balances? You can take a picture or practise your sequence of moves to show us in school.	 <b>Practise</b> We have been counting forwards and backwards to 20 this term. Can you time yourself counting up to 20 and back to 1. <b>Do you get quicker the more you practise?</b> Send in a video of your fastest time or keep practising and perform live in class!	<b>Observe and explore</b> The start of the school year sees some exciting changes in season. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Do you know what season is ending?</li><li>• Do you know what season is starting?</li><li>• How do you know?</li></ul> Can you collect some signs of Autumn to bring in and show us?
<b>Talk</b> Talk to an adult and discuss if you think it would be nicer to be a nurse today or in the past? Why do you think this? Did they agree or disagree? Get ready to tell us about your talk.	<b>Make</b> Can make a sandwich that you think our Tiger who came to tea would enjoy?
