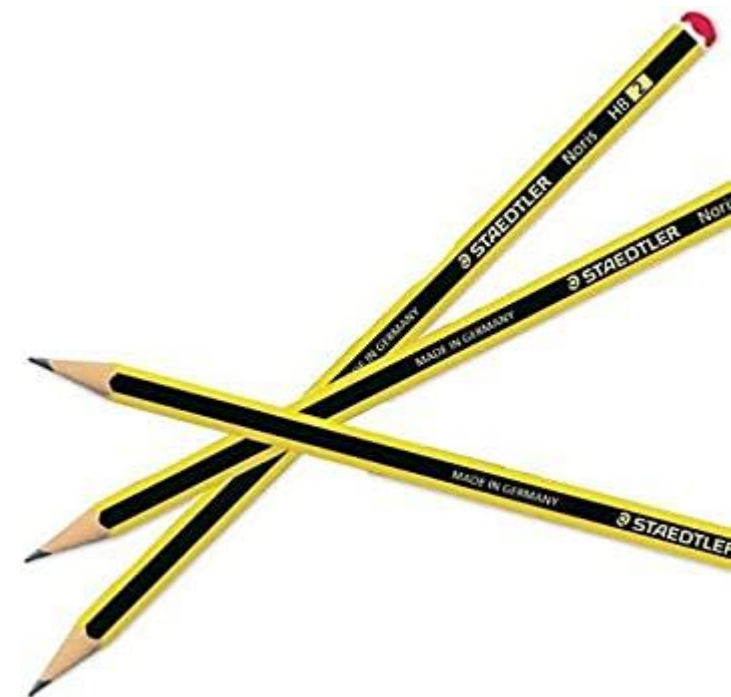

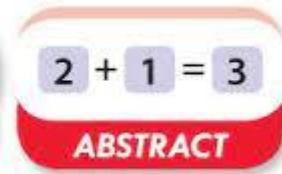
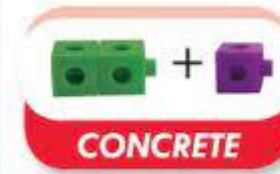
ENGLISH INCLUDING GUIDED READING AND SPaG
