

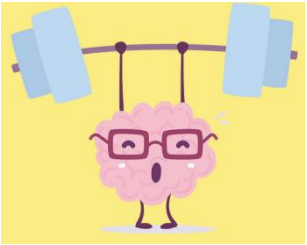

Move

Can you create your own 1 minute astronaut training warm-up?

Think about some of the movements we have practised in our PE lessons.

You can take a picture or practise your moves to lead us in a warm-up at school.

Practise

We have been subitising up to 5 objects in class (recognising that there are 5 without needing to count, e.g. 5 dots on a dice).

Can you play this subitising game? Choose 5 of an object. A grown-up then hides some of them under a tea towel. When the tea towel is removed, you must subitise how many there are.

Observe and explore

Can you record the changes of the moon using this NASA observation sheet?
