#### Move

This term in PE, we will be focusing on balance and co-ordination, with a particular focus on footwork. Can you design and play your own hopscotch? You could include different directions, shapes and even footwork challenges to carry out on different squares.

#### Practise

#### Research and explore

Use non-fiction books, the internet or other information sources to research one or more animals which live in the polar regions. Once you have gathered enough facts, create an animal fact file, poster or PowerPoint to teach others about them.

#### Talk

Discuss with your family the issues we are learning around climate change. What is their opinion on global warming? Do they have any suggestions on how climate change could be tackled? Listen to their points of view and hold a conversation - do you agree, disagree and why? This could help lead into our class discussions too.

#### Make

Use a shoe box or similar sized box to create an Arctic or Antarctic diorama (a three-dimensional miniature model of a scene). Make sure you choose just one and not confuse the wildlife. Remember, penguins do not live in the Arctic!
